

“Brussels Week 2010 – VEWA Academic Scholarships”

About the “Brussels Week”: 22 – 26 February 2010

The “Brussels seminar in European labour law” (the “Brussels Week” is organised by the Institute for Labour Law of the University of Leuven and the Jean Monnet Chair in European Labour Law at *Reflect* (Tilburg University) with the support of the International Society for Labour Law and Social Security Law.

It is designed for advanced level students, researchers and practitioners with a broad interest in European and comparative labour law and industrial relations. The seminar provides a deep and original insight into current issues of European, comparative and international labour law, social policy and industrial relations, in the heart of Europe. Besides being a great academic and mind-broadening experience, the seminar offers a unique opportunity to learn to know how Brussels looks, thinks and works. It includes visits to the major European institutions dealing with labour law and social policy.

Venue

The venue is the Royal Flemish Academy for Sciences and Arts, close to the EU institutions (directions: <http://www.kvab.be/praktisch.aspx>)

Registration

Registration can be made by completing the registration form and paying the registration fee.

The registration fee for students is 75 Euro. For other participants the fee is 175 Euro. The participation fee includes registration for the five days (covering costs for the meeting room, sandwich lunch and administration).

Participants who have attended the Brussels Seminar in European Labour Law have the possibility to receive a “Certificate of Attendance”.

“VEWA Academic Scholarships”

A number of scholarships are available from the VEWA Academic Fellowships Fund. VEWA is the *Association of Educative and Scientific Authors* and aims to foster closer collaboration with researchers from developing and/or transition countries and the Flemish academic and scientific community. Priority is given to students or researchers who are not already present in or near Brussels.

The scholarship amounts to 300 Euro per candidate, including the coverage of travel and/or accommodation costs as well as the registration fee for the Brussels Week. There are 5 scholarships available.

In order to be eligible, the candidate must:

1. Be a national of a developing and/or transition country (e.g. ACP countries, Commonwealth of Independent States, newly entered (since 2004) EU states);
2. Send evidence of his status as researcher or student at a university or research institution;
3. Include a CV in English.

The scholarship will be paid after presentation of the receipts or invoices of the incurred costs of travel and/or accommodation.
